We are headed into missions with TWR!

To my family and friends,

I am excited to share with you how God has been working in my life and leading me into a new season of ministry.

Christ and technology have long been my two greatest passions. After more than twenty years working in IT and walking steadily in my faith, God brought those two together in an unexpected and beautiful way through my work with TWR.

In March 2022, I joined TWR at KTWR Guam as a network and playout administrator. Much of my work focused on the practical, behind-the-scenes backbone of broadcast ministry: maintaining local IT infrastructure, supporting engineering needs, and managing the station's playout system that helped keep programs flowing to listeners across Asia.



Two years later, TWR's operations began shifting in significant ways. I had the opportunity to help implement a cloud-based, distributed playout system, migrating Guam and several other sites to a platform administered remotely by our global team. During this same period, TWR moved toward a zero-trust security posture, reducing reliance on local infrastructure and strengthening resilience across regions. As these changes took shape, my role naturally expanded from supporting a single station to contributing to broader global IT initiatives.

## A fruit-of-the-ministry story: "Carefree in God's Arms"

Miroslav\* is an example of a Jesus follower experiencing lasting fruit. Although his experiences have been a mixture of good and bad, the Serbian man's life has completely changed since he became a Christian. He wants to serve God with a pure heart and be in communion with people who are open to God and his Word, Miroslav said. He gets substantial support from TWR's radio programs in the Serbian language, never missing them.

"It is a place where I encounter God's Word; a time of celebration, prayer, relaxation but also discipline," Miroslav said.



"Whenever I listen, I feel part of God's great family. I feel cuddled, welcome and carefree in God's arms."

He said he's happy to be one of the many who listen around the world in many languages.

In March 2025, I stepped into leadership as Interim Station Director. Shortly after, TWR's Global Leadership Team and Board made the difficult decision to close the KTWR site. With the government of Guam land lease set to expire in June 2026, along with aging towers and transmitters and the increasing cost of operations, it became clear that the ministry needed to move in a new direction. It was a bittersweet moment. Yet it also reflects a new season for TWR. Through a strengthened global partner network, distributed teams, and modern playout systems, TWR can continue reaching listeners without relying on a single station location.



Today, I am leading the KTWR decommissioning project, helping bring nearly 50 years of broadcasting from Guam to a close. While TWR's outreach to Northeast and Southeast Asia continues through other outlets, I have the privilege of stewarding this final chapter with care, gratitude and faith.

As this chapter concludes, I am preparing to step into my next role as a TWR missionary serving with the Global IT team. In this position, I will help plan, implement and support the systems that enable secure ministry operations worldwide — including cloud and server platforms, security architecture, networking, endpoint management and the tools that support TWR's media workflows. My desire is simply to serve faithfully, using the skills God has given me to support those who proclaim the gospel in more than 200 languages around the world.

TWR's Director of Information Technology & Systems, Ben Lykins, says,

*Reaching the whole world with the gospel by mass media requires TWR to use a lot of technology. Nate's broad technology background and skills, combined with his love for people and the gospel, make him a perfect fit to help TWR integrate the latest technologies to reach more people with the gospel of Jesus. Nate has already earned the respect of our global technology team, and I cannot think of anyone more equipped than Nate for this position.*

Andrea, Ella and I have been deeply blessed to be part of the TWR community here on Guam. As we step into this new season, I am building a team of prayer and financial partners who will join us in this ministry. I would be grateful for your prayers — for wisdom, peace, endurance and continued joy in following God's call — and for your consideration in partnering with us as the Lord leads.
